## CATEGORIES

### **DISTINGUISHED SERVICE**

To a Chapter member who, through the distinguished practice of planning, has made sustained contributions to either the development of the Chapter or to the planning profession.

### **PUBLIC SERVICE**

To an individual (or group of individuals) acting in public capacity who has contributed to the public benefits of planning through the promotion or application of sound planning principles or played a significant role in a specific planning project.

### **PUBLIC PROGRAM/POLICY**

To a public program, process or policy of unusually high merit that demonstrates achievable strategies for addressing conservation, development, environmental protection, regional planning or other issues affecting Connecticut's quality of life.

### **COMMUNICATIONS**

For media coverage or an outreach program that broadens the general public's understanding of planning processes, issues, objectives or accomplishments.

### **CITIZEN PLANNING**

To a citizen or group of citizens working in a non-compensated capacity who has/have made a significant contribution to Planning.

### **COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT**

For a project, program or initiative that bolsters the social and economic welfare of the community.

### **PHYSICAL DEVELOPMENT**

For a publicly or privately funded project constructed in the last year that demonstrates the value of pre-construction planning and consistency with CCAPA's mission of compatible development.

### **IMPLEMENTATION**

To an approved/ adopted plan ordinance or regulation that embodies clear and achievable actions through demonstrated results.
